EDURUN 2021 – TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Acknowledged activities

- An activity is considered valid if it is running or jogging 1km within 4-15 minutes and synchronized to 84RACE during the EDURUN 2021 challenge.
- Between March 16th and April 24th 2021, runners complete a minimum distance of 0.5km per activity in order to have it acknowledged. The Personal Rankings are based on 2 criteria in the following order of importance: (1) Longest total distance run (km) and (2) Lowest average pace (Avg Pace).
- On the EDURUN DAY (April 25th 2021), runners watch a livestream video on Vinschool's fanpage at 9 AM and start running during the time frame announced by EDURUN Ambassadors. It is a must for runners to complete a 5-km challenge and send a screenshot of that activity on Strava to the Organizer via Vinschool's fanpage in order to have it acknowledged and get a chance to win prizes. The Personal Rankings on that specific day shall be announced as soon as possible.
- Prize-winners need to send a message to Vinschool via our fanpage with the following details: Prize / Full name / ID Card No. / Tel. / Address / Email address no later than 03 days after the final results are announced. Vinschool shall contact the prizewinners no later than 01 week after they learn how to receive the prizes.
- Vinschool only accepts the activities on Strava that are successfully synchronized to 84RACE.
- Each 84RACE account should be connected to one Strava account only.
- All activities need to be recorded with GPS-enabled devices and reflected in Strava as maps. Strava activities must be set to public.

2. Terms & Conditions

- In case the "Add Others" feature on Strava (aka Group Activities) is used, only the activities of the inviter are considered valid.
- Uploading manual activities to Strava or using multiple devices at the same time to record the same activity is considered invalid.
- All runners should demonstrate a strong sense of integrity. Any activity that shows signs of cheating shall be turned down without prior notice from the Organizer.
- Each individual is eligible to receive no more than 01 prize. In the case that a runner wins more than 01 prize, he or she shall have the right to choose between them.

- The rules of the running challenge can be amended or supplemented by the Organizer at any time during the virtual race, and the changes shall be officially announced on the website of EDURUN 2021.
- The Organizer has the sole discretion to terminate or modify the running challenge or its rules at any time prior to the expiration date by posting the revised terms on Vinschool's website. Continued participation in the competition means approval of the changes made by Vinschool. The contestants agree that Vinschool is not responsible for any damages or losses arising from any change or discontinuation of participation mentioned above.
- In the event of a dispute or complaint related to the competition, the Organizer shall resolve and have full authority to make the final decision.
- The Organizer holds the highest judgment on the prizes.
- By participating in this competition, contestants agree and undertake not to claim, sue or take any legal action, regardless of any nature and/or for any purpose, against the Organizer and/or any organization and/or individual associated with EDURUN and Vinschool.
