



## VINSCHOOL TRANSITION POLICY

### I. Transition from Grade 5 to Grade 6:

Grade 5 students are eligible to transition to Grade 6 at Vinschool if they meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Having completed the Primary curriculum as prescribed by the Ministry of Education and Training (MoET);
- ✓ Being physically and mentally healthy (Vinschool does not provide special support services);

### II. Transition from Grade 9 to Grade 10:

Grade 9 students are eligible to transition to Grade 10 at Vinschool if they meet the following criteria:

1. Having completed the Secondary curriculum as required by MoET;
2. Being physically and mentally healthy (Vinschool does not provide special support services);
3. Maintaining a minimum of “Good” academic performance and “Very Good” conduct throughout their years at Vinschool (from the 2022-2023 academic year until the end of Term 1 of the 2025-2026 academic year);
4. Passing the following subjects: Vietnamese Studies, Global Citizenship Education (GCED), Character and Life Skills Education (CLISE);
5. For students enrolled in the Standard program, admission will be granted in descending order of admission scores until all available slots are filled.

**The admission score is calculated using students’ average grades in lower secondary school (starting from the 2022–2023 academic year):**

$$((\text{Math} + \text{Literature} + \text{ESL} + \text{Science}) \times 2 + (\text{History \& Geography} + \text{ICT}))/10$$

### Notes:

- ✓ The admission score formula will be applied if the number of students meeting criteria 1-4 exceeds the approved number of Grade 10 slots.
- ✓ Students and their parents will be notified of the provisional transition results in January 2026. These results will only be confirmed if students maintain at least “Good” academic performance and “Very Good” conduct in Term 2 of Grade 9.
- ✓ Students who received a **“PASSED” notification for** the Grade 9 to 10 transition at Vinschool, based on the aforementioned criteria, may choose one of the following two pathways for official admission:
  - Option 1: Use their transition results announced by Vinschool to complete enrollment procedures in accordance with the regulations.
  - Option 2: Use their results from the Grade 10 entrance exam organized by the local Department of Education and Training (DoET) to apply for admission:
    - The passing score will be announced by Vinschool once the official entrance exam plan is issued by DoET.
    - Students will be admitted only if their scores meet or exceed the passing score announced by Vinschool and there are still available slots at the time of application.
